

IGLU-DORF DAVOS INFORMATION FOR OVERNIGHT GUESTS



Dear guests,

Soon we will be able to welcome you to the Iglu-Dorf Davos, which lies 2,550 m above sea level. To ensure you are properly prepared and equipped, please note the following information to help you enjoy the igloo experience to the fullest.



ARRIVAL

We are committed to sustainability. Please play your part and travel to the Iglu-Dorf by public transport. Arrive relaxed, on time, avoiding the traffic jams and in a climate-friendly way.

Take the train to Davos-Dorf station. From there it is a five-minute walk to the Parsennbahn valley station.

By Car: On entering the Davos-Dorf village, drive past the railway station. Then take the first junction on the left in to Mühlestrasse. The paid Parsennbahn car park is signposted. *IMPORTANT:* Cars may not be left overnight in the car park (fine CHF 100.-), but this does not apply to Iglu-Dorf guests if your car is parked in the designated night-time parking spaces marked for Iglu-Dorf (*immediately after the entrance barrier*). If the parking spaces are occupied, please use the parking facilities in the parking garages of Davos. From the car park it is a five-minute walk (*underpass*) to the Parsenn valley station. Your booking confirmation entitles you to obtain a night parking ticket from the ticket counter of the valley station at a discounted price of CHF 10.-, which you can use to exit the barrier the next day.

Take the cable car to the middle Höhenweg station. Once there, change to the second section and travel to the Weissfluhjoch station at the top. The return ticket for pedestrians costs CHF 43.-. If you want to ski the next day, you can buy a single mountain trip along with the ski pass for the next day after 3.30 pm. (*Keep in mind: online order is recommended for the ski pass due to capacity restrictions*)



MEETING POINT & PROCEDURE

Please allow enough time for your arrival because you have to travel up to us with the mountain railway, which only runs during regular skiing hours. **The time and place for the meeting point are fixed** and apply to all guests equally. It is not possible to travel directly to the Iglu-Dorf and no individual arrangements can be made.

If you do happen to be late, please inform us immediately by calling +41 41 612 27 28.

- Board the Parsennbahn by **3.30 pm** at the latest
- **4.00 pm: meeting point at Panoramarestaurant Weissfluhjoch**
- **Approx. 4.30 pm:** group hike to the Iglu-Dorf (*approx. 20 minutes*)
- Arrival, aperitif, room check-in
- Approx. **7.00 pm:** dinner
- Snowshoeing, wellness and a relaxed get-together
- **7.00 am:** morning tea served to you in your sleeping bag
- **8.00 am:** hike to the Weissfluhjoch mountain restaurant
- **8.30 am:** breakfast buffet in the Weissfluhjoch mountain restaurant, individual departure

LUGGAGE STORAGE

Only take as much luggage as you really need or want to carry with you to the mountain. For those of you who want to enjoy another day or two of skiing in addition to the night in the igloo, note that there are no lockers at the top station. Luggage may be deposited there at your own risk.



CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT

The Iglu-Dorf is in a remote location on the mountain. Equip yourself appropriately for the outdoors. The temperature in the igloo is relatively constant, around freezing point.

- Warm clothing suitable for winter (*think what you would wear for skiing*)
- Warm, lined winter shoes
- Good gloves (*ideally two pairs*)
- Dry socks, long underwear to change into, pyjamas if necessary
- Two hats (*one as a spare in case the first hat gets wet*)
- Towel, swimwear, flip-flops for wellness activities if necessary
- Head torch or flashlight
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Sunglasses & sunscreen
- Mask(s) (*masks are compulsory in the Iglu-Dorf*)
- Ski goggles (*in case of wind and snow*)

The ideal piece of luggage is a backpack. Suitcases with wheels are not suitable.

We will provide you with an expedition sleeping bag (*suitable up to -42°C*) with a hygienic sleeping bag liner for the night.



MORE INFORMATION

Should there be any changes or important information at short notice regarding an existing booking, we will contact you via the mobile number you have provided.

Travel cancellation insurance

We warmly recommend that you take out travel cancellation insurance during the cold season, for example with [Allianz Global Assistance](#). This also covers the costs if you fall ill with COVID-19 or are personally ordered to self-isolate by the authorities.

Not included in the price are travel to and from the destination, the mountain railway tickets, drinks, visitor's tax and any souvenirs.



CHECKLIST

- Equipment packed as described in the Clothing & Equipment list
- I have read and understood the safety instructions
- Planning your arrival: weather, allow extra time
- You will be carrying and are contactable on the mobile phone indicated at the time of reservation
- Adequate insurance: cancellation costs, travel cancellation, rescue, foreign insurance if applicable

SAFETY INFORMATION FOR OVERNIGHT STAYS IN THE IGLOO-VILLAGES

High alpine hazards

Iglu-Dorf GmbH herewith expressly draws the attention of its overnight guests to the environment of the Iglu-Dorf in remote, high alpine nature. Even a short walk can entail high alpine risks. High alpine hazards refer to concrete phenomena such as strong winds, cold, altitude, visibility conditions, snow and ice, sudden changes in the weather, unknown terrain, amongst others.

As the weather cannot be influenced, this can affect the activities during the overnight stay. Activities in the open air (for example visiting the whirlpool) are adapted to the weather situation, i.e. not carried out in the worst case.

Respect nature!

Coordinate your activities to your abilities and physical condition and the high alpine environment. Stay overnight only if you are in good health.

Emergency management

A safety concept exists if accidents occur. Rescue transportation may take some time given the exposed location and the weather, and may even be impossible in exceptional circumstances.

No rescue transport will be carried out for minor injuries. The client is responsible for any costs for rescues.

In the Iglu-Dorf, there is an AED (defibrillator), emergency chemists with disinfectant, ointment, compresses, materials for dressings, tweezers. We are not allowed to stock or issue any other materials or medicines. The guest is responsible for such items.



COVID-19

The health and safety of our guests and staff is our highest priority. We adhere to the guidelines & recommendations of the Swiss [Federal Office of Public Health](#) and the [canton](#). Leaving the Iglu-Dorf Zugspitze during avalanche detonations

To avoid natural hazards, it may be the case that you have to leave the Iglu-Dorf Zugspitze during avalanche detonations, even though it is not in a zone at risk of avalanche. The instruction to leave can be issued in the middle of the night. You may have to leave in the middle of the night, perhaps without being able to return to the Iglu-Dorf, with makeshift overnight accommodation in the mountain restaurant.

Concluding remarks

Iglu-Dorf GmbH makes every endeavour to ensure that incidents can be avoided. To this end, we also rely on the cooperation of our overnight guests. Please follow the instructions and advice of the igloo guides.

The need to leave the Iglu-Dorf on account of avalanche detonations is on average necessary 2-3 nights per season, based on experience from the past three years.

Restrictions to the offer do not justify any price reduction.

We finally wish to point out that after meanwhile more than 130,000 overnight guests, incidents can be counted on one hand. We shall do our utmost to make sure this remains the same. We thank you for your cooperation and look forward to enjoying a pleasant and relaxed atmosphere with you in the Iglu-Dorf.
