IGLOO-VILLAGE GSTAAD



Please read this document carefully in order to be properly prepared for the Igloo-Village experience.

Gstaad is the magnet of the region and neatly unites tradition, a welcoming atmosphere and style. Restaurants, shops, hotels and bars are harmoniously arranged in the traffic-free village centre. The surrounding skiing and winter hiking areas are accessed by three mountain railways. The Gstaad Igloo-Village is located close to the Saanerslochgrat mountain station above Saanenmöser at an altitude of around 2,000 m above sea level. From here you can enjoy the imposing view of all surrounding valleys and mountains.

During your journey

The Igloo-Village Gstaad is located at the heart of the Saanerslochgrat ski resort. Please note that the journey up the mountain with the Saanenmöser-Saanerslochgrat railway takes around 15 minutes and the walk to the Igloo-Village takes around 5 minutes.

For activities with a fixed starting time, any claim to forfeited services and refund shall lapse if arrival is more than 30 minutes late. This also applies to bookings with adventure vouchers. If you are late, please let us know immediately on +41 41 612 27 28. Please have the mobile telephone you specified on reservation with you so that we can contact you if need be (especially during your outward journey).

Ascent & mountain railway tickets

The railway station at Saanenmöser is easy and simple to reach by train. From Saanenmöser railway station, the valley station Saanenmöser-Saanerslochgrat is about 5 minutes' walk.

If travelling by car, follow the signs to the railway station once you have entered the small village of Saanenmöser. Carry on driving along the station street until you arrive at the car park on the left under the tracks. Follow the signs to the Saanenmöser-Saanerslochgrat cable lift valley station.

Then go from the valley station of the gondola "Saanenmöser-Saanerslochgrat" to the top mountain station.

Guests using the railway without skiing equipment may purchase a regular mountain/valley trip. Of course, you can also travel to the Igloo-Village with a valid ski pass.

The mountain railway tickets and any parking charges incurred are not included in any package.

Equipment

The Igloo-Village nestles in the heart of nature on the mountain. Make sure you are properly equipped. Normally the temperatures in the Igloo-Village remain constant at around freezing.

Clothing and equipment:

- Winter-proof, warm clothing (such as for skiing, see picture above)
- Comfortable, warm winter shoes (e.g. snowboard shoes or moonboots)
- Good gloves
- Cash
- Sunglasses and sun cream

A backpack is the ideal item of luggage for the visit in the Igloo-Village.
